Ludwig was born in 1955 in Frankfurt and initially trained as a wholesale and foreign trade merchant. In 1982, he began his airfreight career at Air Canada in Germany and went on to join Air New Zealand in 1997. There he acted as the Head of Air Cargo for the United Kingdom and Europe until 2008 when he joined AirBridgeCargo.

Ludwig Hamburger was an exceptional and respected executive with broad international experience and his region has played an important role in the growth and development of AirBridgeCargo. With his passing not only AirBridgeCargo Airlines but the entire air cargo industry loses a dedicated personality. He always fulfilled his responsibilities and duties with great personal commitment and always stood up for the interests of his employees.

The development of the air cargo industry was always close to Ludwig's heart and he worked actively for years within the BARIG Cargo Committee, most recently as its Chairman.
